

What is the Transient Occupancy Tax (Bed Tax)?

- Adopted in **1999** by the Village of Millersburg
 - A **3% tax** applied to all **short-term rental bookings**
 - **Chapter 185** of Codified **Ordinances** of Millersburg, OH

How the Funds Are Used

Each year, the revenue from the Bed Tax is distributed to **four community organizations** whose work strengthens Millersburg's economic development:



Millersburg Lions Club

Supports community events, beautification projects, and local service initiatives.



Holmes County Historical Society

Preserves local history, maintains historic sites, and promotes heritage tourism.



Holmes County Antique Festival

Organizes Millersburg's long-standing annual festival, drawing visitors and supporting local businesses.



Historic Downtown Millersburg

Enhances the vibrancy of downtown through preservation, events, and business support.
