# What is the Transient Occupancy Tax (Bed Tax)?

- Adopted in 1999 by the Village of Millersburg
- A 3% tax applied to all short-term rental bookings
- Chapter 185 of Codified Ordinances of Millersburg, OH

### How the Funds Are Used

Each year, the revenue from the Bed Tax is distributed to **four community organizations** whose work strengthens Millersburg's economic development:



### Millersburg Lions Club

Supports community events, beautification projects, and local service initiatives.



## **Holmes County Historical Society**

Preserves local history, maintains historic sites, and promotes heritage tourism.



## restival Holmes County Antique Festival

Organizes Millersburg's long-standing annual festival, drawing visitors and supporting local businesses.



## Historic Downtown Millersburg

Enhances the vibrancy of downtown through preservation, events, and business support.
