Resurfacing/Sidewalk Projects: Informed Council the proposed resurfacing locations for 2022 are S. Mad Anthony, S. Grant, W. Adams, Newton, Engel, Deetz and Smith streets, Rye, Canary, Swallow, Centre, and Horn alleys. Sidewalk projects will focus on the S. Washington/ODOT project as we will have r/w acquisition costs, but I am planning on repairing several sections including N. Washington near Ace Hardware, S. Washington near Taco Bell, S. Clay around Millersburg Dental and the Lutheran Church, and Glen Drive. The majority of these are potential candidates for leveling versus replacement.

<u>Comprehensive Plan:</u> Informed Council we should be receiving a draft of the community survey soon. Once that is finalized it will be distributed throughout Holmes County. Please respond and encourage everyone you can to respond.

<u>163 N. Crawford Street Purchase</u>: Informed Council closing took place on 12/27 and we now have possession of both homes. Troyer noted he will be following up with the County to see the timing of the potential demolition funding so the project can move forward.

<u>Council Chambers A/V</u>: Informed Council Alstage Lighting and Sound is proceeding with the A/V setup for recording/broadcasting meetings.

<u>First Aid/CPR Training:</u> Informed Council the first of two training sessions was held today. There were five employees that attended. The next class is scheduled for January 14 at District One.

<u>Office Building Improvements</u>: Informed Council we will be receiving a quote soon to replace all the fascia, siding and upper south wall windows on our building as well as to repair the stonework on the south wall of the building.

<u>ODOT Consent Legislation:</u> Informed Council he anticipates having a resolution before Council at the next meeting granting ODOT consent to rehabilitate a culvert that lies partially in the Village corporation limits. This culvert is under S.R. 39/U.S. 62 at the east end of town in the dip by the golf course.

AEP Upgrade Project

AEP is scheduled to complete an equipment transfer project on 1/17 on Clinton Alley (behind Millersburg Brewery/Bags). During this time, Clinton Alley (N. Clay to N. Crawford), N. Monroe Street (E. Jackson to Clinton Alley), and the Hub parking lot will be closed. AEP has notified customers that will be without power during this work and the make-up date for adverse weather is 1/24.

<u>Water Leak</u>: Informed Council Richard Shoemaker had a water leak around an outside spigot. Nate Skolmutch confirmed the water did not enter the sewer system.
