<u>Personal Time:</u> Informed Council Dispatcher Caleb earned 48 hours of personal time in October of 2021. With him enrolled in the Police Academy and the department being short staffed, Cox was not able to use his personal time balance by the end of 2021. Chief Shaner requested Council allow his year end balance of personal time to be carried over to 2022 and noted this must be used by the time he finishes the academy. Motion made by Conn to allow the carryover of personal time. Seconded by Polen. Upon roll call, motion carried with Conn, Polen, Vaughn, Hofstetter, and Shoemaker voting aye. **Prospective Employee:** Informed Council the individual, Dustin Chase, who was offered the position of patrolman, accepted and then declined the position. He has accepted a position with another department where he is close to home and the hourly wage is higher. (\$4.00 more)

<u>Resurfacing/Sidewalk Projects:</u> Informed Council he met with SJL on the resurfacing project and the stimulus projects (Wooster Rd. water line replacement/N.Grant storm sewer improvements) we are pursuing. They are preparing preliminary documents to get these projects underway.

<u>Comprehensive Plan:</u> Informed Council a draft of the survey is being reviewed and will soon be distributed.

163 & 187 N. Crawford Street Demolitions: Informed Council the County has not yet received the demo funding but will alert us once they do.

<u>AEP Upgrade Project:</u> Informed Council what was previously scheduled for 1/17-AEP, and was rescheduled to be completed for the equipment transfer project on 1/24 on Clinton Alley (behind Millersburg Brewery/Bags)., has once again been canceled. They will reschedule once the weather cooperates.

<u>Park Improvements:</u> Informed Council we will be starting to work on improving the facilities at Airport Park in the near future and once the weather breaks, we will be working on the fields. Troyer said he has talked to both baseball and softball board members and they are excited for these improvements as they both indicated that they will be using Airport Park. Softball has the opportunity to acquire a used scoreboard and Troyer noted he agreed to assist in installing this at Airport Park. The baseball board is also talking about new scoreboards, audio system, and cameras at Deer Run Park and has asked us to consider sharing some of the cost if we have money available after the improvements at Airport Park. Council briefly discussed contributing to the new scoreboard, and felt it should be considered if funds are available after Old Airports improvements are completed.

Deer Run Park Exercise Equipment: Informed Council the final two pieces of equipment have arrived. Installation will begin when weather allows. There was also discussion on the possibility of installing cameras and lighting at Deer Run.
