We won the auction for the Durapatcher in Hancock County. The purchase price was \$17,200 plus a 12.5% buyer premium for a total of \$19,350. Hardy Twp. has paid half of this amount as we agreed. We are planning to get it sometime this week if the weather allows. Both ODOT and Holmes County Highway Department have offered training.

Street Sweeping

We are looking into renting a sweeper for a week this spring. If we do this, we will look at doing a thorough cleaning of the mains, downtown and also be able to hit the various neighborhoods that rarely get swept. The cost for sweeper rental by the week is expected to be \$4,000-\$5,000. To purchase a street sweeper, Troyer estimates the cost would be \$200,000-\$400,000.
