<u>DRB & P&Z Commission:</u> Informed Council P&Z will meet on Wednesday June 1st to review a variance application from the H.C. Commissioners for excess square footage for the proposed Health Dept. building on Glen Drive and a variance application from Kevin Strouse for not meeting minimum square footage for a proposed residence at 162 N. Crawford St.

<u>Resurfacing/Sidewalk Projects:</u> Informed Council there are no updates on the 2022 Resurfacing project. Right of way work continues on the ODOT TAP Project and utility relocation schedules are being finalized. <u>ARPA Projects:</u> Informed Council the CDBG application was submitted and we are awaiting word on any award.

<u>Personnel:</u> Informed Council Blake Judson will complete his one-year probation on May 25th. He recommends taking Blake off probation at this time as he has done and continues to do a great job. Motion made by Vaughn to remove Judson from probationary statues and classify him as a full-time permanent employee. Seconded by Conn. Upon roll call, motion carried with Vaughn, Conn, Shoemaker, Hoffee, Hofstetter, and Polen voting aye. Voting Results: Yes: 6 No: 0

<u>Monitoring Well:</u> Informed Council a request has been made for an additional monitoring well to be installed on the north side of the village parking lot (across from Bag's). The installation will be done during off-peak hours and will take approximately three hours. No objections were heard.

<u>Under the OneOhio Memorandum of Understanding</u>: Mayor Huebner brought up the draft resolution for discussion. Hoffee noted some research she completed at recoveryohio.gov. OneOhio is the Foundation/mechanism set up by the Governor to distribute opioid settlement funds and outline how they can be used. Of any settlement dollars received, 30% will be distributed directly to 19 regions, with funds distributed to every township, village, city and county in the State. 55% will go to the OneOhio Foundation, and 15% goes to the OAG. Holmes County is in Region 11. Currently, the settlement is \$808/M. Mayor Huebner stated as Millersburg is the largest municipality in Holmes County we need to appoint someone to the Region 11 Board of Directors to help determine how and where the OneOhio Foundation money is allocated (within our region). This appointment can be a Village Official, but does not need to be. He has asked Chief Shaner to consider representing Millersburg on the regional board.

<u>Liquor License Transfer</u>: Informed Council a liquor license transfer was received from the Dept. of Liquor Control. The transfer is from Olde World Bakery Inc. to Cider Press LTD. The license is a D5 permit which allows for sales of beer, wine, prepackaged low proof mixed beverages, and on premises only consumption of high-proof spirits all until 2:30 am. Shaffer noted the required background check was completed on the owners by the Police Dept. with no records found. Council has a right to request a hearing on the request. Motion made by Hoffee to not request a hearing. Seconded by Shoemaker. Upon roll call, motion carried with Hoffee, Shoemaker, Polen, Hofstetter, Vaughn, and Conn voting aye.
