#### ANIMALS

There is an ordinance against animals running free.

All dogs in Ohio must be licensed by the age of three months. Licenses may be obtained at the Holmes County Auditor's Office, 75 East Clinton Street, Millersburg, OH 44654 in person or by mail. Call 330-674-1896 for more information. You may also purchase licenses at the Holmes County Dog Warden's Office, 5387 CR 349, Millersburg, OH 44654 or call 330-674-6301 for more information. The pet owner's name, address, and description of the dog is required. Calls concerning animals should be directed to the Millersburg Police Department, 330-674-5931.

#### **BICYCLES**

Bicyclists must obey all traffic regulations, but bicycles need not be registered.

#### **BUILDING PERMITS**

Building permits may be obtained from the Village of Millersburg Office. Prior to receiving any permit from the Village, you must first obtain a zoning permit by contacting our Zoning Inspector at 330-674-1886. Forms and requirements are posted on the Village's website: millersburgohio.com. Click the Departments link and then select Planning and Zoning Commission.

#### **CEMETERY**

#### COMMUNICATIONS

The Mayor and Village Council use various forms of communication to keep residents informed of meeting dates and times, community services, financial information, meeting minutes, and upcoming community events.

#### EMERGENCY SIREN SYSTEM

The Village of Millersburg has a siren warning system that will sound during a tornado warning or other emergency situations. Village residents should seek shelter upon hearing the warning system. The warning system is tested every Saturday at 11:00 a.m.

#### FOR ALL EMERGENCIES CALL 911

Fire Department – Holmes Fire District No. 1 handles fire and medical emergencies. Holmes Fire District No. 1 is located at 8478 SR 39, Millersburg. The station telephone number is 330-674-1926 for non-emergency inquiries.

Police Department – The Millersburg Police Department maintains 24-hour-a-day, 7 days a week protection for Village residents. The department is located at 6 N. Washington Street, Millersburg, the Village Hall, 330-674-5931.

#### HISTORIC DOWNTOWN MILLERSBURG

Historic Downtown Millersburg hosts several events including Girls Night Out, Vintage in the Village, Thunder over Holmes County, Art Exhibition, Boo in the Burg, and Christmas Open House and Chocolate Walk. #### JAMES CRISSEY MEMORIAL POOL

The pool is operated by the Holmes County Park District and is located at 430 West Jackson Street. The telephone number is 330-674-3353 or you can check on Facebook for information.

#### LEAF PICKUP

The Village of Millersburg collects leaves throughout the fall season for residents. The crews will pick up loose leaves and bagged leaves on the tree lawn beginning late October and continuing until Mid-November. Crews will only accept leaves during this collection. Lawn waste and tree limbs will NOT be accepted. Residents are also asked to remove leaves and debris from catch basins and gutters to prevent damage caused by blocked storm water inlets. #### OPEN BURNING

The Village has adopted the Ohio EPA rules for open burning which prohibit all trash burning. Please refer to Village of Millersburg Codified Ordinance 1511.

Recreational fires are permitted. Please refer to Village of Millersburg Codified Ordinance 1511.05.

#### PARKS/RECREATION

The Village of Millersburg has three parks within the Village limits. Deer Run Park is located at 4102 Glen Drive, and Old Airport Park is located at 1030 S. Washington St., Clay Street Park is located North of 425 S. Clay St. Deer Run Park has a dog park, a skate park, disc golf, baseball fields, playground equipment, basketball court and an amphitheater. Old Airport has baseball fields, playground equipment and a sports court with basketball,

pickleball, and tennis courts. Clay Street Park has playground equipment and a basketball court. All parks are open during daylight hours or as legally posted.

The Village of Millersburg maintains the park grounds. There are pavilions available for gatherings at all three parks. Call the Village Office Administrative Assistant at 330-674-1886 to make a reservation. There is no charge for reservations.

## HOLMES COUNTY PARK DISTRICT/RAILS TO TRAILS

A recreation/transportation paved trail through scenic Holmes County that accommodates bicyclists, pedestrians, horseback riders, buggies, etc. Fifteen miles is paved from Fredericksburg to Killbuck with another seven and one-half miles paved from Glenmont to Brinkhaven Ohio. #### ANTIQUE FESTIVAL

The Holmes County Antique Festival is held the 5<sup>th</sup> weekend after Labor Day in Historic Downtown Millersburg.

#### TREE CITY

The Village of Millersburg Tree City Commission is responsible for all the publicly owned trees throughout the Village. Tree City is responsible for maintenance, care, and planting trees in the tree lawn or devil strip along village streets.

Millersburg has been recognized as a "Tree City USA" every year since 2015.

#### SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

The Village of Millersburg is responsible for the replacement of damaged sidewalks in the public right of way. If your sidewalk needs replacement, please contact the Village offices at 330-674-1886 for an evaluation. Property owners are responsible

for snow and ice removal of the sidewalks located in the public right-of-way adjacent to their property.

#### SNOW REMOVAL/PARKING BAN

In the event of snowfall of two or more inches, a parking ban on Jackson Street, Clay Street, and South Washington Street from Jackson Street to Adams Street will go into effect so crews may effectively plow and salt the streets. Vehicles not moved during the parking ban will be towed at the owner's expense.

#### TRASH REMOVAL

The Village of Millersburg has contracted trash removal services for all village residents with Kimble Trash & Recycling Services. The scheduled pick-up for trash is every Friday. The scheduled pick-up for recycling is every other Friday. One bulk item or three extra bags are permitted on the first Friday of each month. Saturday will be the pickup day during a holiday week.

To begin trash removal services, call Kimble Companies 1-800-201-0005.

All village residents are encouraged to participate in the curbside recycling program on pickup days. Recycling days are every other Friday of each month. Kimble's monthly costs include trash and recycling carts. Contact Kimble Trash & Recycling Services for more information.

Kimble Trash & Recycling offers a low volume user program for residents whose weekly trash output is minimal. To participate, call Kimble 1-800-201-0005. Bags for the program can be purchased at the Village Hall.

Trash will be delayed one day when Holidays occur Monday through Friday for the following Holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup>, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.

In the spring, the Village also hosts an annual cleanup day for residents. Household waste and

debris may be brought to the Village Street
Department Facility on the announced date for free
disposal. Watch our Facebook page and/or local
media outlets for announcements on when the
cleanup day will be held each year as well as for a
description of what all waste is accepted.

#### OTHER RECYCLING PROGRAMS

Holmes County also offers a recycling program at 5401 CR 349, Millersburg.

#### UTILITIES

Electricity delivery is provided by American Electric Power and Holmes Wayne Electric. The Village citizens approved an opt-out aggregation program for electricity generation. (American Electric Power customers only)

Residents with American Electric Power will receive a letter on information to enroll or to opt out from the Village's current supplier contract.
